Brief project description:

From November 2018 to December 2021 Alinn Banmaw Local Development Organisation (ABLDO) implemented a project with 400 small-holder farmer and landless households in 10 villages in Momauk Township, Kachin State. The project aimed to support improved livelihoods and resilient communities. This extension to the project will continue to provide follow-up support in the original 10 villages, while also reaching an additional 453 households in 10 new villages in Momauk Township.

Key components include:

- CBO Capacity Building to support village-based groups to gain knowledge, skills, and organizational capacities to take forward and lead their community livelihoods priorities.
- Provision of small grants for improved food security and income generation initiatives. This includes direct support for basic food items for especially vulnerable households.
- Skills building for women's empowerment and leadership, and the provision of small-grants for women to take forward their priority action plans.
- Partner capacity support, to further develop the skills of the partner's staff and the organisation's policies and procedures.
