Brief project description:

This 3-year project targets 540 direct beneficiary households (approx. 2,700 people) in 18 villages in Mogaung and Mohnyin Townships. In addition, the project specifically targets 360 women (20 women per village) for focussed women's empowerment activities in the 18 villages. The project aims to assist villagers to build improved and more resilient communities and livelihoods through supporting women and men farmers to self-organise into Farmers Groups to collectively address their priority livelihoods issues; providing relief support for especially vulnerable households; supporting small-holder farmers to improve farm viability through agroecology and better access to affordable credit and quality seeds; increasing women's empowerment and leadership; and strengthening farmer and community networks..
